4.0 Introduction to Paper Crafting & Tools (3 Hours)

Objectives:

- Tools: Paper Trimmer, Scissors, Scoring Board, Adhesives
- Craft Blades, Punches, and Guillotine Safety

- Challenge: Create a textured tag or embellishment cluster

Practice: Make a matching envelope for a card

- Lab: Build a small gift card box with decorative trim
- Bonus: DIY envelope punch board demo
